A **survey** was conducted in July-August 2021 to verify residents' concerns and support for NDP Policies. The 36 questions were of three types...

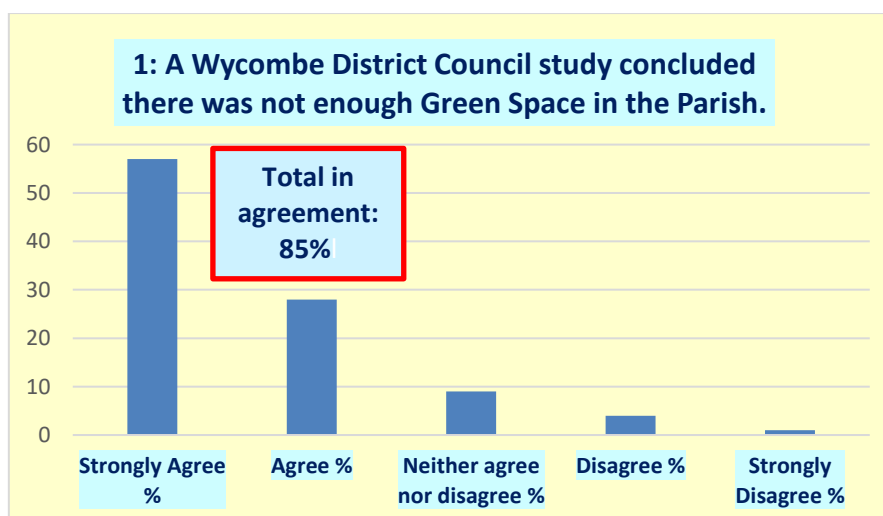

2. **15 Questions required a multi-choice response;** these are covered by individual charts in Section 2 of this Appendix.
3. **3 Questions required a written text answer.** These are not amenable to being charted. The written responses are held by the Parish Council and are available at the Parish Office on request.

The original Survey Question Number is shown against each as [Qnn].

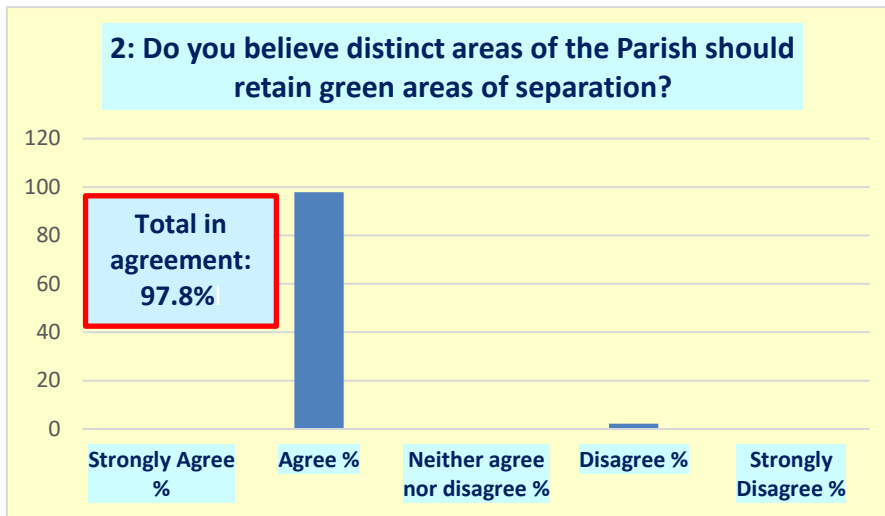

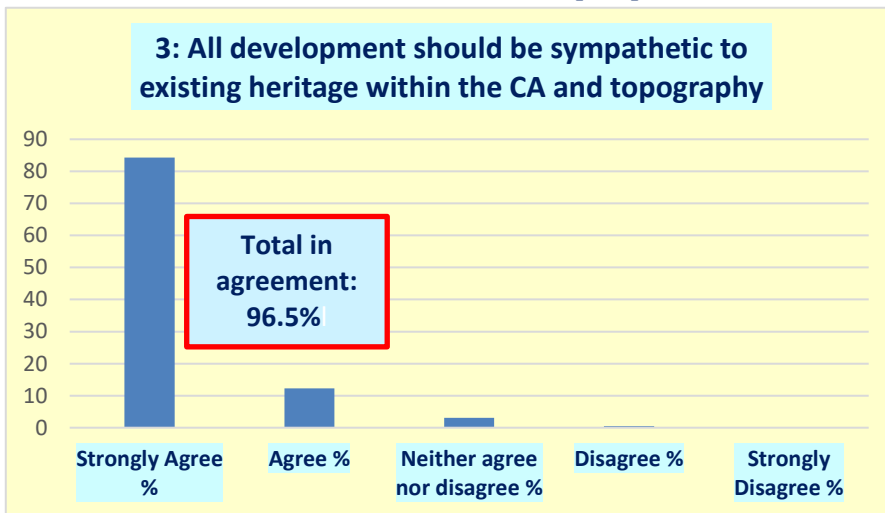

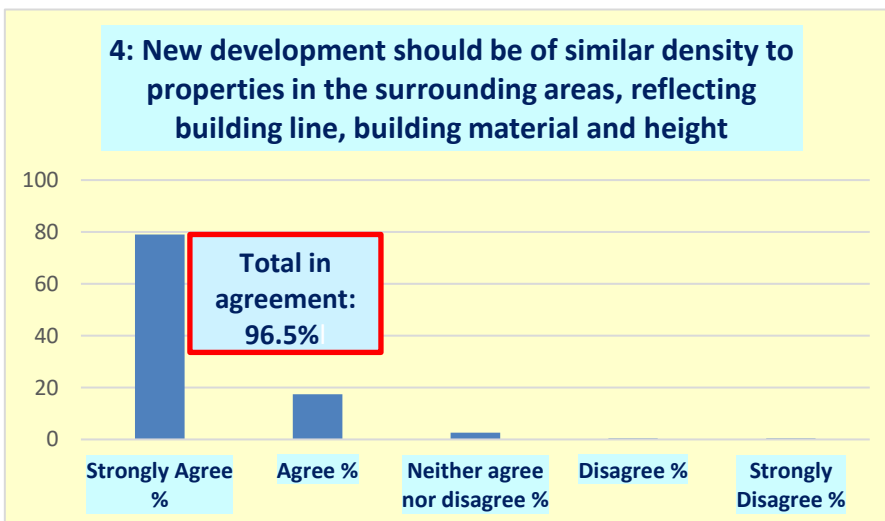

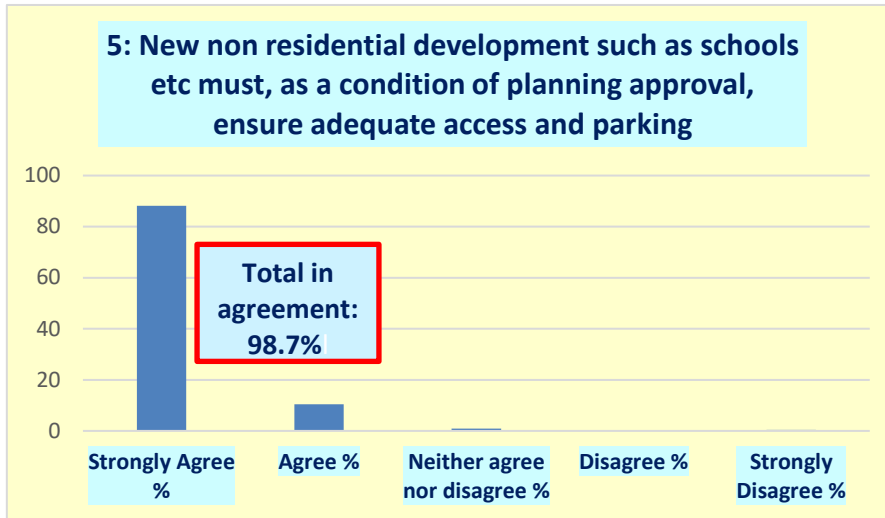

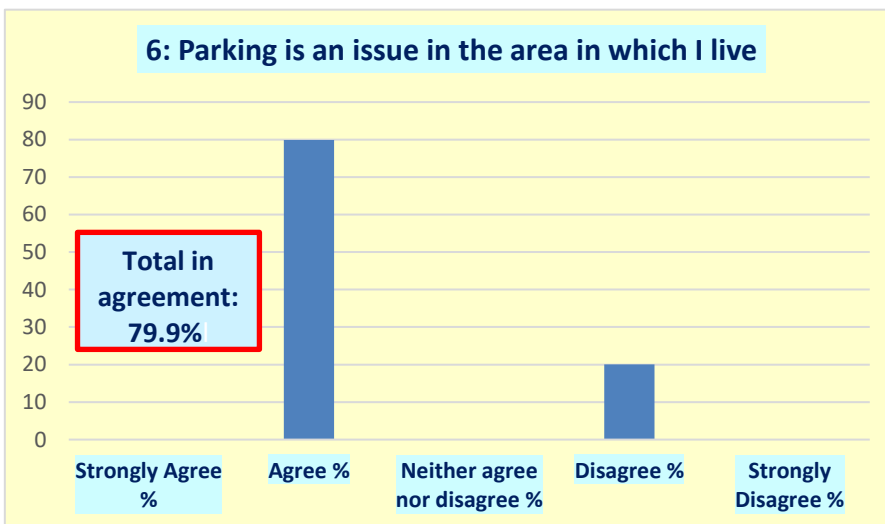

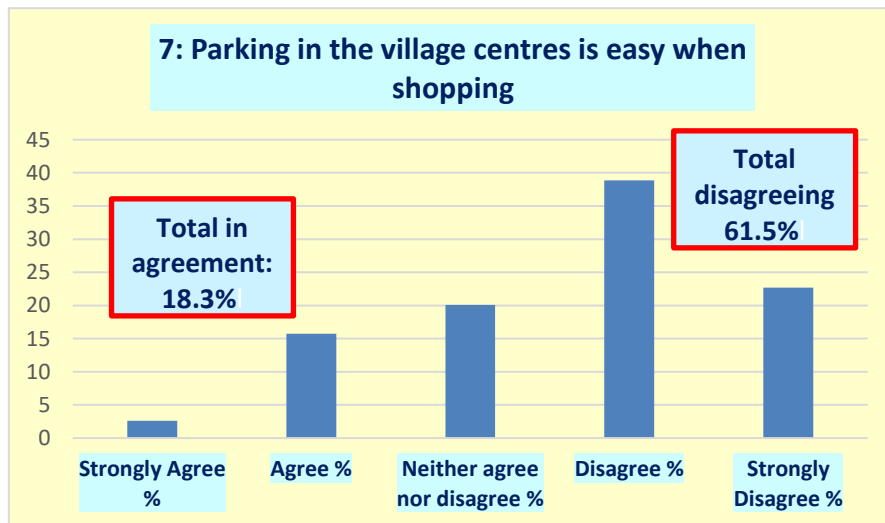

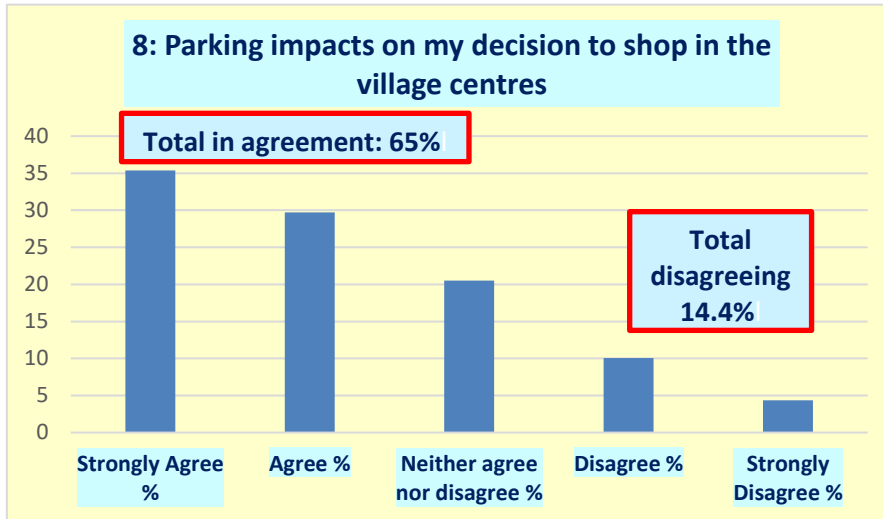

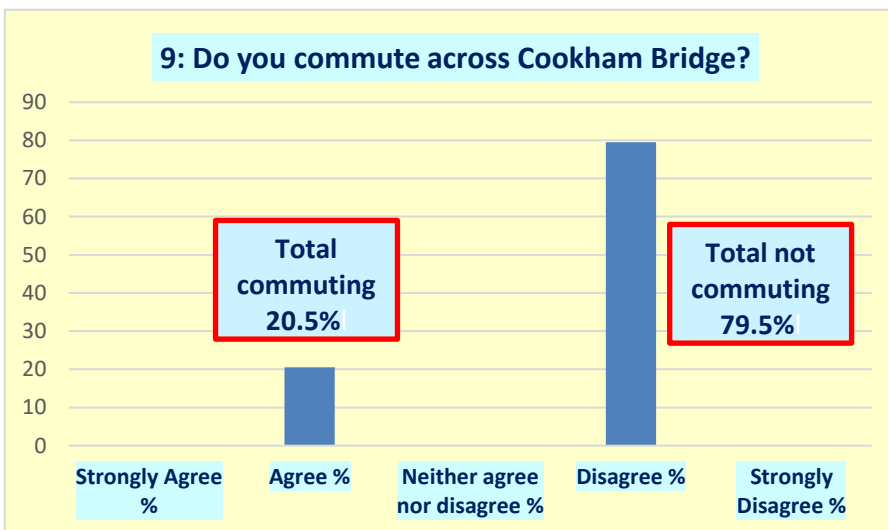

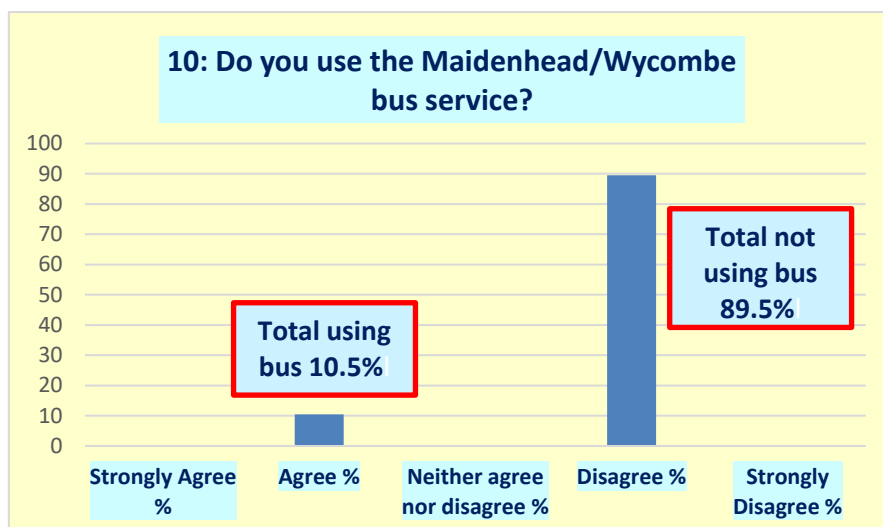

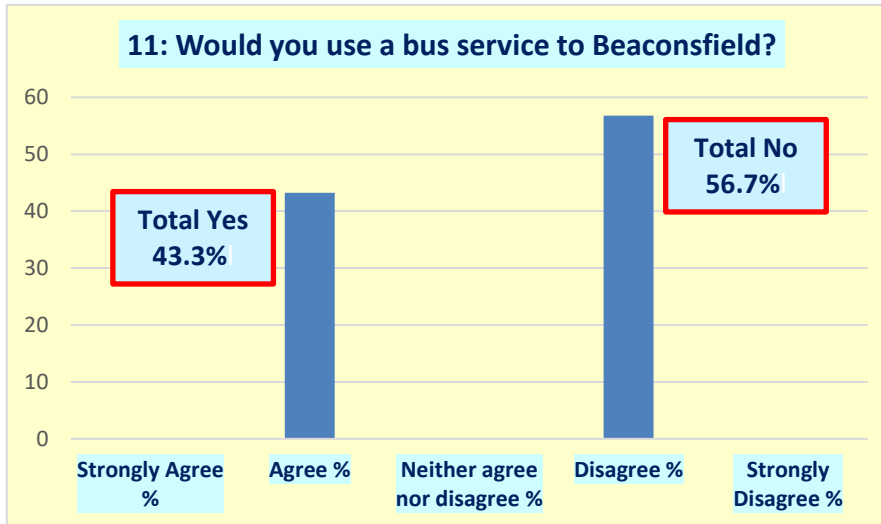

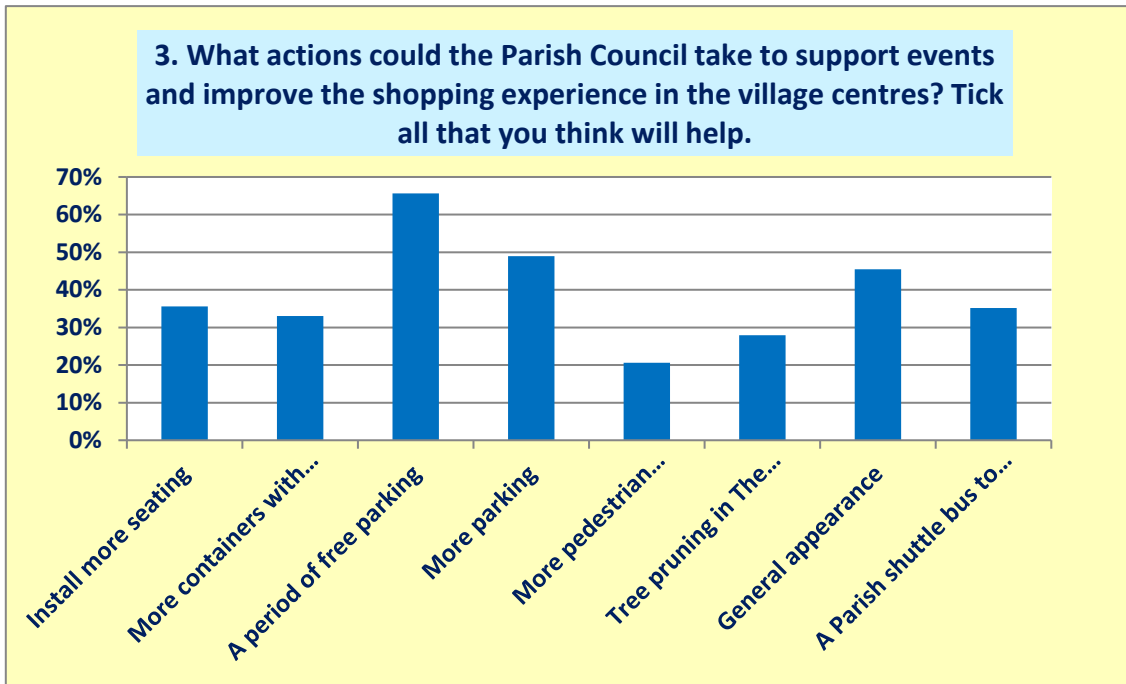
